







#1_¿Do I need to pay anything when I register and submit my abstract?

Short answer:

No, you do not need to pay anything when registering for the congress and submitting an abstract. You will only need to make a payment if your abstract is accepted and you decide to officially register for the congres.

Detailed response:

No, you don't need to pay anything during registration and abstract submission. Simply register on the congress website, upload your abstract, and that's it. If you click on "Congress registration," you will have to pay, but this can be done after your abstract is accepted and you decide to participate in the congress. You can view your information under "My account/My profile." You can upload your abstract in "My congress/Abstract submission" and verify it in "My congress/My abstracts." By the way, note that you have the option to submit more than one abstract.
